Comment Submitted:

I beleive that development resources are better utilized dispersing energy generation closer to users. In this way risks associated with outages are minimized and the grid is more robust overall. Getting fuel and altenative/renewable generated supplies to these "distributed" sources will still require trans-shipment over long distances, but existing, long-distance transmission routes and infrastructure should have some capacity come available as generation sources are relocated closer to users.
