To expedite future environmental analysis processes, the BLM and FS should include specific language in the Energy Corridor Programmatic EIS that will allow the establishment of utility corridors in individual BLM Resource Management Plans and FS Forest Plan without these agencies having to prepare separate plan amendment documents in addition to the site specific EA or EIS for a proposed corridor project. In other words the agencies should mandate that only one NEPA document be prepared for the establishment of any new energy corridor project. Multiple documents cost too much and require too much time. The Energy Corridor Programmatic EIS should require the streamlining of the corridor establishment process for individual BLM Field Offices or FS District Offices.
