1. How long after completion of the PEIS does the BLM expect to take before the new corridor(s) are identified and made available. In the past, a lack of available BLM personnel has contributed to many delays in getting permit applications processed.
2. After a corridor is designated will it still be necessary to have the usual NEPA studies etc. done.
3. Will the BLM be the only agency that needs to be contacted? I am envisioning a permit similar in nature to the US Army Corps of Engineers Nationwide permits that do not require much additional agency contact by individual companies. Will this be true?
